Buy	Buying	Bought
Catch	Catching	Caught
Fight	Fighting	Fought
Teach	Teaching	Taught
Go	Going	Went
Stand	Standing	Stood
Sleep	Sleeping	Slept
See	Seeing	Saw
Throw	Throwing	Threw
Leave	Leaving	Left
Fly	Flying	Flew
Be (is/am/are)	Being	Was/
Has/ Have	Having	Had

Some words end in 'e'. When we add +ing, we drop the 'e'.

Care	Caring	Cared
Like	Liking	Liked
Share	Sharing	Shared
Taste	Tasting	Tasted
Dance	Dancing	Danced
Close	Closing	Closed
Write	Writing	Wrote
Drive	Driving	Drove
Ride	Riding	Rode
Bite	Biting	Bit
Hide	Hiding	Hid

Chase	Chasing	Chased
Come	Coming	Came
Smile	Smiling	Smiled
Shine	Shining	shone

When +ing is added to some verbs, then the last letter is doubled.

Hit	Hitting	Hit
Jog	Jogging	Jogged
Shop	Shopping	Shopped
Knit	Knitting	Knitted
Get	Getting	Get
Sit	Sitting	Sat
Run	Running	Ran
Cut	Cutting	Cut
Put	Putting	Put
Win	Winning	Won
Swim	Swimming	swam
