Version 2-

Two Injured in Collision on MG Road

MUMBAI, January 12, 2025 - By Rohit Sharma

A collision between a cargo truck and a sedan resulted in two injuries at the MG Road-Hill Street junction this morning at 9:00 AM. The injured individuals have been admitted to City Hospital.

According to Traffic Inspector Patil, the truck allegedly violated a red signal, leading to the collision with the sedan. "The truck driver has been detained for questioning, and we are reviewing CCTV footage from the junction," he said.

Dr. Mehra from City Hospital reported that both drivers are in stable condition. "The sedan driver, Mr. Kumar, sustained minor fractures, while the truck driver has some lacerations. Both are under observation," she stated.

The accident caused traffic disruptions for approximately two hours. Traffic police implemented diversions through Hill Street and Normal Road to manage congestion. Senior Traffic Officer Mrs. Desai confirmed that the damaged vehicles were removed by 11:00 AM and normal traffic flow has resumed.

Local residents have long expressed concerns about this junction's safety. "This is the third accident here this year. We need better traffic management," said Mr. Sinha, president of the local residents' association.

The police have registered a case and are conducting further investigations.
